Navigational Notes # 12

What is the "24 Hour Clock System"? The "24 Hour Clock System" is used to eliminate confusion between AM and PM times of day. 12 hours is added to all the PM times.

AM	PM
0100	1300
0200	1400
0300	1500
0400	1600
0500	1700
0600	1800
0700	1900
0800	2000
0900	2100
1000	2200
1100	2300
1200	2400

When 2 digits are placed in front of the time, these digits represent the day of the current month.

The "24 Hour Clock System" is often referred to as "Railway Time", "Military Time", or "Astronomical Time". Coordinated Universal Time (UTC) previously known as Greenwich Mean Time (GMT) should be used when Vessels are engaged in International Voyages. The accepted abbreviation for UTC is the letter "Z" (ZULU).
